People's Science - Ruha Benjamin 2013-05-22

Stem cell research has sparked controversy and heated debate since the first human stem cell line was derived in 1998. reflect a wider array of social concerns, stem cell research— from African Americans' struggle with sickle cell treatment to the recruitment of women as tissue donors—still risks excluding many. Even as regenerative medicine is described as a participatory science for the people, Benjamin asks us to consider if "the people" ultimately reflects our democratic ideals.
